

Colombia/Venezuela DM2 Romans Workshop

Thank you for your prayers and financial support for our trip to Colombia. Your prayers were answered in amazing ways and God's hand of blessing, provision and protection was seen and felt throughout our time there.

On November 14th Bret Nazworth and I met up in Bogota with Oscar Portes, a Venezuelan church leader and former engineer who, together with his wife, Edith, were a tremendous blessing to the Nazworths and me in 1998-1999 when we served in the little town of Morichalito, Venezuela. Oscar's administrative gifts were greatly helpful on this trip.

On November 15th us "three amigos" traveled to Puerto Carreño, Colombia. We hit the ground running in order to secure a place to hold the workshop and house and feed the Venezuelans who were coming. Over the next two days we were thrilled to receive almost every person who had been invited. As each of the 23 attendees arrived, they shared their story of how God's sovereign hand of provision opened doors, bus seats and borders for them to be able to make the trip that seemed financially, physically and logistically impossible.

On November 17-22 we held an intensive workshop through Romans 1-8. It was a blessing to see so many pastors and church leaders get a clearer understanding of essential biblical truths and hear them testify of how it was already changing their lives. During the breaks in teaching, and sometimes late into the night, many encouraging conversations took place. What a privilege to be able to invest in the spiritual lives of these dear brothers and sisters!

Because of the dire living situation in Venezuela, we also made it a priority to spoil them as much as possible with three solid meals a day, multiple "cafecito" breaks and even two outings for ice-cream. For many of them, it had been years since they had been able to enjoy little things like a soda, a hamburger or ice-cream. Because of the generous giving of believers in America, we were able to send each attendee home with a backpack of study books, a flash drive loaded with years of teaching material, a small cash offering to help them purchase much needed supplies, and a box filled with basic staples such as sardines, flour, toothpaste and soap. This generosity had them in tears and they wanted us to express their gratitude to you and let you know they would be praying for you. - **Jonathan Rath**
