Fellowship Bible Church: Greenville, TX



I remember the first time I was introduced to the DM2 curriculum in Tullahoma, TN. It was a session on the Panorama of the Old Testament, just days after my wrist surgery. I say "remember" loosely as I was somewhat medicated and the rate at which the information

was flowing was staggering. I believe a good way of describing it would be "drinking from a fire hose." The session was enlightening, easy to follow and revelatory. I also remember speaking with Pastor John at the time about how it would look and be received if we brought it to our church. We agreed the material would be well worth implementing, so shortly after, we began teaching the Old Testament Panorama to our adults during Sunday school.

The three of us who attended the Tullahoma session rotated the teaching duties and we narrowed the fire hose approach down to something more at our own pace. The format remained the same, but the change in pace allowed for more interaction. It also allowed for side conversations about what the Word was doing through the material in the lives of those attending. I've heard

numerous times comments like, "I never saw that...", "I like the connection the references make," and even "I don't see or understand the point." I particularly like the last comment as it shows that the material draws people to their own study, further conversations and finally a clearer understanding.

The understanding we would encourage is that of the Word not of our own as Proverbs 2:6 tells us: "For the Lord gives wisdom; from His mouth [come] knowledge and understanding."

To this day, four years and four panoramas later, we continue to use the DM2 curriculum to teach Godinspired understanding to our adult Sunday-schoolers. It is a tool that continues to bring new insight to what the Bible says and a study guide that leads students through their own walk. Not relying on gimmicks or theatrics, though we do enjoy the various animated slides, the material is laid out plainly as not to distract from the Word. Our teaching has followed the original model to ensure consistency. This is intentional in the event any of our students would be interested in participating in teaching sessions with DM2, if an opportunity presented itself. As such we urge the congregation of Fellowship Bible Church to learn and gain understanding to not only replicate that knowledge through the DM2 curriculum but also themselves grow in their love of the Word.

What has the DM2 curriculum meant to Fellowship Bible Church in Greenville, TX? I truly hope that question has yet to be answered as we continue to grow in Him but I would like to say, so far, in a word - impactful.
