This year one of the churches that does DM2 training in Africa lost its building due to fire. An overseas organization that wears the name Christian has viciously attacked people we train. Last year (2016) by God's grace our church, Sun of Righteousness in Krasnoyarsk, Siberia, was able to host our first DM2 workshop where we studied the book of Hebrews. The workshop went very well and the church was greatly edified and encouraged. As a result, our people understood more clearly the precious heavenly ministry of the ascended Lord. Some have testified to their prayer lives being changed. Thanks to their greater faith in Christ's complete work, they have now learned how to approach the throne of grace with greater confidence.

When that workshop was over, we all agreed to have a DM2 Colossians workshop the next year (August 23 – September 3, 2017). So, ever since last fall, we were looking forward to studying Colossians; however, the Colossians curriculum was not yet translated into Russian. We dove in and did the translation of this excellent material. Even during the translation stage, Colossians helped us correct some difficult marriage issues that were happening in our church.

In our local church, we are blessed to have two Bible teachers – Pastor Sasha and his assistant. As we prepared the workshop schedule, they began digging into the epistle. It was immediately edifying to both of them personally.

The majority of our church members attended the workshop. According to the schedule, on weekday evenings we planned 3 hours of teaching and 5-6 hours on the weekends. It was hard to follow our schedule because during the breaks everyone was so active in fellowship and discussion of the truths they were learning. The people enjoyed the teaching very much.

When interpreted and understood properly, the book of Colossians provides liberation from the creeds of legalism, mysticism and worldly philosophy that are so prevalent in Russian churches. There are many different Bible courses available in Russian, including studies on Romans, Galatians, Ephesians, and Colossians, but none of them put as much emphasis on positional truth as the DM2 curriculum does. We especially enjoyed the focus on Jesus' person as the one and only Godman, His redemptive work, and His present priestly activities in heaven. It was reviving and empowering to hear over and over again that we are identified with the Lord in His death, burial and resurrection and that faith in these truths is the only way to live pleasing to God. The book of Colossians shatters all human systems of counterfeit spirituality. As we taught, you could almost hear crashing sounds in the room as false ideas were torn down one by one.

As with the book of Hebrews, the book of Colossians emphasizes the heavenly ministry of Jesus Christ, but this time from Paul's perspective. Colossians highlights our position in Christ, a position that is accompanied with supernatural spiritual blessings and a responsibility to follow godly principles appropriated supernaturally.

Besides the doctrine in the book of Colossians, Paul gave many unusual commands that are almost entirely ignored by churches today. These are grace commands that deal with the invisible thinking of a Christian. Sadly, many Christians are not concerned with the unseen issues of the heart and tend to put the focus on external conformity. It is hard to shift people's attention away from the external, but that

is exactly what Paul did in Colossians and the DM2 Colossians curriculum strongly emphasizes this grace perspective.

Based on the doctrine in Colossians and on the inward commands to change our thinking, Paul finally added teaching on Christian practice. Only after discussing the person of Jesus and our identification with Him does the book introduce the section on Christian ethics. Thanks to the focus of the DM2 Colossians curriculum, we have come to understand that ethics without grace is legalism.

The family relations part of the curriculum was mind-blowing. There are so many problems in Christian families and our people desperately need grace-based, yet strong and straightforward, teaching on marriage and parenting. We'd like to thank the authors of the curriculum for paying special attention to the relationship sections of the epistle.

Unlike the DM2 Hebrews workshop we did last year, this time we did not have many guests from other churches in attendance. We think that on one hand this was due to the fact that many Christians don't want to invest the time necessary to study the Bible intensely. On the other hand, persistent opposition from a leading denomination has done much harm. Christians from the other churches who

were formerly positive have been turned away from our church because of the grace focus of our teaching. Nevertheless, the ministry of DM2 has reached Siberia.

Note: In September of 2013, the author of this article, Vladimir Zuev, became acquainted with DM2 through a Romans 1-8 workshop he attended while still a student at the Word of God Bible College in Kiev, Ukraine (James F. Myers Ministries). After Vladimir and his wife Lena graduated and moved back to their home town in Krasnoyarsk, Siberia, they facilitated two DM2 workshops through their local church. In the summer of 2016, they first studied Hebrews and this year Colossians. While they received some outside help from DM2 teachers, Vladimir and Pastor Sasha have done the majority of the training, which has been enthusiastically received by their church. There in Siberia, churches are becoming more and more controlled and repressed. Also, opposition from denominational churches has placed a damper on workshop attendance. In spite of all this, DM2's team teaching style has fortified at least one local church's disciple-making efforts there in Siberia. Would you pray for the Sun of Righteousness Church to become an oasis for grace and disciple-making there in the heartland of Siberia?
