From the Teachers:

Front Range Bible Church displayed tremendous hospitality in hosting the DM2 Panorama of the Old Testament workshop. The curriculum provides a better understanding of the Old Testament and a clearer picture of the Lord Jesus Christ. The training, though long hours and intense, provides continuity of thinking, scriptural insights, and application for the believer in Christ regarding the Old Testament. Each student is provided with a notebook, copies of the audio lessons, and PowerPoint slides so that he or she is able to replicate the teaching to others.

The Old Testament Panorama teaches God's plan throughout human history; and where we, as believers in the church, fit into that plan. Additionally, it lends to a clearer understanding of the Gospel of Christ, i.e., "He died for our sins and rose again." Pulling this thread from the **Garden to the cross**, where Christ becomes the substitutionary sacrifice for our sins, brings the **entire perspective** of His plan **into view**.

After lengthy planning and preparation, including much prayer, five teachers and a dozen students gathered at our church to acquire a panoramic view of the Old Testament. Over the course of three days and 36 hours, almost the entire curriculum was eagerly taught and studied. The teachers were a diverse lot: Bret Nazworth, president of DM2 from Texas; Carlos Tellez, Bible teacher from North Carolina; Brad Rigby, DM2 regional ministry director and youth teacher from Georgia; Titus Kennedy, from Seattle, WA; and myself, pastor of Front Range Bible Church in Denver, CO.

The variety of backgrounds of the teachers is critical in understanding the flexibility of the DM2 materials. The lessons were easily stepped into by each of the teachers without loss of continuity or momentum. Each 75 minute lesson covered a portion of the history of the Old Testament, combining the historical, prophetic, and poetic books of the period. This chronological approach has the advantage of setting the true panorama of the Old Testament into the minds of the learners. The DM2 learning method is via PowerPoint and a companion workbook, which has blanks to fill in as they are revealed on the PowerPoint. A copious amount of Bible verses are quoted and serve as a useful tool for quoting in the classroom and launching into principles of the spiritual life. Each teacher followed the same PowerPoint

slides and curriculum, yet taught with his own personality and teaching style. Although most of the students were local, one attended all the way from Coeur d'Alene, Idaho. Several who attended were not regulars at the host church. The rigorous nature of the course developed a wonderful camaraderie among the teachers and attendees. By the end of the three days, fast friendships had been formed. Remarkably, though taxing, there were no complaints about the challenging nature of the course. If anything, the challenge was an excellent element of the training, motivating the students to go all the way to the end. The benefits are simple: a thorough overview of Old Testament history from the viewpoint of God's plan and a great starting point for further study.

One part Bible class, one part marathon, the recent DM2 seminar in Denver was a time of great learning and fellowship. The seminar, which covered the Panorama of the Old Testament, was fast-paced and kept the interest of everyone attending—even though the sessions lasted from morning until night. The PowerPoint slideshows and notebooks were simply, but brilliantly, designed. By way of the keyword fill-in-the-blank concept, the course required constant thinking and interaction. This kept everyone engaged, and thus provided them with a complete notebook of all the material covered. **Each teacher** had his own **distinct** style, and this served to add variety and unique insights. This seminar also showed that the concept can work even in the US, where busy schedules are often the excuse for lack of involvement in church, and a correct and deep understanding of the Word of God is increasingly diminishing. The most encouraging part of the seminar, however, came at the end when a few enthusiastic students expressed the intent to go out and re-teach this material according to the disciple making concepts of Matthew 28:18-20 and 2 Timothy 2:2.

DM2 training is now a safe haven for a lot of the pastors we are training, especially those who have never had any form of training at all. They are so eager to continue with the training and are looking forward for the October workshop.

About 150 people continue to be effectively trained by DM2. One particular DM2 trainee has already taken his pastor's family and others through the Panorama of the Old Testament course. Another continues to teach his church members in two of his church branches.
