Thank you for your prayers before and during our workshops in Mexico City and Arlington, Virginia. Both were new fields for DM2. We taught Romans 1-8 in Spanish and the Lord did amazing things. No matter the country or language, when the grace of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ is clearly taught, the Holy Spirit allows people to understand the good news of the gospel. After they understand the grace of God, the clear way God begins to work in their lives is truly amazing.

In Mexico, our team of Roberto Morales (Bolivia), John Wry (Canada), and myself experienced how God works in marvelous ways. It was such a blessing for me personally to be able to participate in nearly the whole week of training. Almost everyone present overwhelmingly stated how they now thoroughly understood that their salvation in Jesus was secure forever and not dependent on any works.

John Wry (Canada), Keith Nazworth (Virginia), and myself made up the team that taught in Arlington, Virginia. We were slated to hold our workshop in a local church's normal meeting place: an auditorium in a nursing home. However, because of a virulent stomach virus at the nursing home, the doors were closed to everyone from the outside. As a result, we moved furniture out of the pastor's home and converted it into a workshop center! I believe this more intimate atmosphere played a big part in allowing the church leaders and members to really listen and understand the book of Romans. God used something unplanned to create an atmosphere that helped us depend even more on Him and not our own plans and strength. The Word of God was once again well received as God's precious grace was clearly taught. The church was refreshed and renewed in a way the pastor could never have imagined. Those who attended were extremely appreciative and plan to pass on these truths to the others in their church, their families, and beyond.

To God be the glory for all of the great ways He is showing Himself to the people being reached with DM2 teaching around the globe as well as to us as we continue to minister through this organization! Our family is so blessed to be involved in this work!

As I passed by the beautiful government buildings and museums in Washington D.C. around 3:30AM the morning of my departure, I gave thanks to the Lord that our dependency is not on any government institution nor on our best efforts to be a "success" in this world, rather, our trust is in Jesus Christ alone!

Brad Rigby (RMD):

Enduring temperatures exceeding 100 degrees (without air-conditioning or fans), approximately thirty men and women listened to thirty-four hours of Bible teaching that covered Romans 1-8 and the *Disciple Makers* curriculum. During the workshop, these Asian men and women were challenged with the fact that the Lord is all about building His church. (Matthew 16:18). It is God who commanded us to "go and make disciples" (Matthew 28:19-20).

As a disciple-maker, this was my first experience returning to a country where we had already taught Romans 1-8. I was greatly encouraged to see that those whom we had previously taught were walking in the truth (3 John 4). Five of the men who attended the previous training in October of 2013 returned this time to help teach others. This is what DM2 is all about!

Obviously, these men had prepared their lessons through much study, laboring over the scriptures. In fact, one local teacher's wife said, "My husband was up until after midnight studying." One of these teachers created his own local illustration of the three phases of salvation using an indigenous tree! Another brother utilized the same diagram to illustrate the three lanes (immoral, moral and religious) of the broad road to hell from Romans 1-3. Many expressed their intention to teach others what they had learned.

At our first workshop, people only asked a couple of questions about the material taught, and they did so in private only. On this trip, the people overcame this barrier and shot out questions both in public and private. Many of their questions dealt with concerns regarding eternal security. We were able to explain certain troublesome passages. These questions were truly exciting for Craig and me because it meant that the Holy Spirit was working in their thinking about the spiritual life. Even communicating through an interpreter, we were able to see the "lights" of understanding turn on in their eyes.

On Saturday, Craig taught at a church service attended by approximately eighty people, and on Sunday I taught in a service attended by approximately forty people. At each service, the gospel was clearly presented: "Christ died for our sins and rose again." And we challenged the people to believe it.

Please continue to pray for these men and women that they will become disciple-makers. My prayer is that they will have the reputation of Paul and Silas in Acts 17:6: "these men who have upset the world." God is clearly working in the lives of these brothers and sisters through His word of truth. This country has become an exciting field of ministry for me. I invite anyone interested to contact me about the next trip. The people have already invited us to return in September or October of 2014.



Craig Northcott (Team):

This trip to Myanmar was my fourth international trip with DM2, but it was full of firsts.

First, this trip was the first time I was able to return to the same place. When we were there in October, we taught Romans 1-8. When we returned in March, we taught that curriculum again as well as the *Disciple Makers* curriculum. It was great to see familiar faces and build on the relationships started the previous trip.

That leads me to my second first. By returning, I was able to see how God had worked in these men and women's lives. It is amazing what He has accomplished. Five local men taught 1 or 2 sections each in Romans 1-5. Although it was difficult to know exactly what they taught because of the language barrier, it was clear that they had worked hard to prepare. They brought in scripture references that were appropriate and demonstrated an understanding of the passage they were teaching. Also, they developed their own diagrams (which were very good) to help explain the principles. These men are equipped and able to teach others. It is very encouraging to see God's model being successfully put into practice through the work of DM2.

The third first was that Brad and I went on this trip without Bret or any other "professional" teacher. Talk about intimidating! It was wonderful for my personal edification and spiritual walk. The Lord once again proved that He can use a very imperfect tool such as me to serve Him if I simply rely on Him.

I believe great things are about to happen in this part of Asia. I look forward to rejoicing in the spreading of God's word through those faithful men and women who attended the workshop. I thank all of those who participated in this trip through their prayers and financial support. Those efforts and sacrifices are producing fruit in this country.

I give praises to God who sends able teachers of DM2 to help us be able to reteach others. Thank you DM2, especially Brad and Craig, for coming here personally to teach us. In this workshop I have learnt the three-fold package of salvation: justification, sanctification, and glorification. This makes me bold to present the true and clear gospel. I believe I had the opportunity to

attend this workshop because God wants to use me to reteach

the clear gospel. May God bless DM2's efforts everywhere.
