In Matthew 28:19, Christ commanded his followers to "make disciples of all the nations." The command literally reads "make all the nations disciples." We often break this command into two separate clauses, making our focus either on making disciples or on all the nations. But although disciple-making on a local level is intrinsic to the Lord's commission, it shouldn't stop there. Christ's desire from the very beginning of the church has been disciplemaking on a world-wide level. This requires either personally going forth or participating in the sending forth others.


For "whoever calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved." How then shall they call on Him in whom they have not believed? And how shall they believe in Him of whom they have not heard? And how shall they hear without a preacher? And how shall they preach unless they are sent? As it is written: "How beautiful are the feet of those who preach the gospel of peace, who bring glad tidings of good things!" Romans 10:13-15

This is what gets a disciple-maker up and going each morning with renewed determination and energy. Every person who recognizes the important task of making disciple-makers lives intentionally. Just this last week I conversed with two ladies from two different states. Both

of them have been trained by DM2 and both expressed this same sentiment. They are excited that they now have something tangible to do and they cannot wait to get it out to others. When disciple-making is taught scripturally, people get it and they get in the game. This is happening the world over.

Sometimes we hear encouraging comments from people not directly involved with DM2 but who are using our materials. Here is one such quote taken from an email I recently received from a sister in Christ: "I will be using the Romans study in the Episcopal Church... This is such an opportunity to clarify the Gospel in a church where the truth can get lost amidst the ritual, and therefore must constantly be emphasized and reaffirmed." I cannot thank the Lord enough for the recent trip to Sierra Leone. The next three days were spent teaching the Romans 9-16 curriculum which helped clear up some misunderstandings concerning God's past, present, and future dealings with Israel, as well as some of the church's responsibilities in this present time. The curriculum also cleared up several false teachings that are popular in Sierra Leone and supported the truth with plenty of Scriptural evidence they can take back to their churches.

I am very pleased with the work the Lord is doing in Sierra Leone and feel overwhelmingly privileged that the Lord has allowed me to serve Him in this capacity. I cannot wait until I am able to return to continue to help this core group move through the DM2 program and watch how the Lord uses these faithful men and women. # Zambia

For I am not ashamed of the Gospel of Christ for it is the power of God unto salvation... Romans 1:16

Thank you for praying for our recent teaching trip to Zambia. The Bible is true when it says the effectual fervent prayer of the righteous man avails much. It was evident throughout our trip that God was leading and in control.

For starters, because of flight delays and mechanical problems, I arrived at the Dallas/Fort Worth airport 10 minutes after my flight to Frankfurt, Germany was scheduled to leave. Amazingly, the Lord caused strong head winds to delay the arrival of our plane coming from Germany. So, even though I arrived late, I still had 35 minutes to make it to my gate! When I arrived with only minutes to spare, Bret's comment was, "That was a real nail biter!"

Off we went to Frankfurt, Germany, then on to Addis Ababa, Ethiopia, then to Lusaka, Zambia. From Lusaka we boarded a small mission plane to Kasama in northern Zambia. Kasama is around 600 miles from Lusaka and takes a full 3 hours in a Cessna 206 to arrive. We arrived in Kasama jetlagged.

The next morning, by God's grace, we began the workshop. Each day we taught 8 to 9 hours. The meetings were well-attended. There were 130 students present. Most of them were pastors and church leaders who had been with us in October. We taught the Making Disciple-Makers manual first. The emphasis was on 2 Timothy 2:2 with the idea of teaching faithful men who will in turn teach others also. That material was well received. Next, we taught verse by verse through Romans 1 to 8. This material was a repeat for some of the students, but we all felt it was very necessary as Satan has

brought so much confusion concerning the Gospel. Romans chapters 1 to 5 allowed us to very clearly focus on the Gospel message. Remarkably, the Holy Spirit opened the eyes of many to the truth. Thank you for praying! Continue to pray for those who attended to now go forth and teach others. Some of them have already been using the materials we left the last trip and are carefully teaching in their churches. To God be the glory.
